

ALYESKA SKI CLUB JUNIORS RACE DAY VOLUNTEER POLICY

As parents/guardians of participants in the Alyeska Ski Club Juniors Program, you play a crucial role not only through the support you provide your child/children, but also in supporting the program on race days, as it takes as many as 30 people to staff a USSS or FIS race. We have a very strong tradition of involving families in our ski races. Having a volunteer staff for these events helps us to host a safe and well run event as well as helps keep program prices lower for the entire club.

The Alyeska Ski Club has instituted a Race Work Day Policy that applies to all families with participants in U10-U19 programs. Every family is asked to contribute a specific number of race work days according to the following sliding scale:

U10 = 2 days

U12, U14 (Part and Full-time), U16/U19 Part-time = 4 days

U16 and U19 Full-time = 5 days

Race day volunteer duties are outlined here <https://alyeskaskiclub.com/volunteer/>. Volunteers must sign up on SignUpGenius prior to each event in order to get credit for the days worked. Some positions are only available to volunteers who are certified Officials (Referees, Chief of timing, Race Administration, etc). These Officials positions will be tracked separately and the volunteer will receive credit accordingly. If you are interested in volunteering in a position that requires certification, please watch for posting of Officials Clinics in the Fall. Most positions do not require any certification and many positions don't even require any experience.

Work Day Deposit

In order to help assure that the club receives the required volunteer support, a work deposit is assigned for each athlete program. For families with MULTIPLE ATHLETES at ASC, the work deposit is based on the athlete's program with the highest work deposit amount. It is important to note that contributions toward the total work days is considered as total family contributions!

Each Work Day is worth \$100. A deposit will be assessed after registration and either the full or a partial amount will only be charged to your account if you are unable to fulfill the race day volunteer obligation. We don't want your money, we want you to participate in as many events and races as possible to ensure we have a safe and fun race season!

U10 = \$200

U12, U14 (Part and Full-time), U16/U19 Part-time = \$400

U16 and U19 Full-time = \$500

NEW FOR THE 2021-22 SEASON - Deposits will not be collected during registration. Rather deposits will either not be charged at all or charged partially or fully in April, 2022 once race day volunteering as been reconciled for the season.
