

Hello Saas-Fee Families,

We are getting close to our Saas-Fee camp departure, and I don't know you, but I am getting pretty excited to go back to Europe. To prepare for our amazing trip I would like to give a few brief points that should be done as soon as possible.

The travel consent form:

For the athletes traveling with the team to Milan, (many of you are), please start working on the travel consent form as early as possible. I would like to give a hard deadline of **July 8** for me to collect all these forms on paper form from you. As soon as you have the completed document, please contact me and we will arrange a meeting point.

Camp Full Payment:

Remember to give a description of your payment so that Leah knows where to allocate the funds. If you are unsure what your balance is please send an email to Leah officemanager@alyeskaskiclub.com and she will be happy to let you know what your balance is.

USSS Membership Current 2022-2023:

All athletes attending this camp will need to be current with their USSS membership. **Important for athletes seventeen and older:** you will need to have your own membership; this means that you will no longer be linked to your parent's account. This process will take longer as you will need to go through a background check and Safesport. I suggest working on this as soon as possible.

European Currency:

There are ATMs available in Europe, but it may be good to have 200 – 300 Euro cash at hand, you can check with your bank prior to departure to order the amount needed. You will not need Swiss Francs as businesses in Saas-Fee will accept the Euro currency. Please remember to check with your bank to ensure that credit cards and ATM cards work in Europe.

Waxing Irons:

I will provide three waxing irons that work in Europe – We will share these irons amongst all athletes.

Power Adapters:

As you all may know, Europe has a different electrical system than in U.S. Therefore you will need an adapter for your computer and cell phone such as these: [European Adapter](#)
Items such as hairdryers that only have 120V will not work with a simple adapter, you will need to purchase a converter to make such items work.

Condor Extra Ski Bag:

Last week I spoke with one of the Condor supervisors in Anchorage regarding the extra ski bags the athletes will be traveling with during this camp. She said that there is no problem at all to pay for the extra bag at the counter, the cost per way should be \$160. She did however say that even though Condor doesn't really promote using the call center, she did say to try a couple of times and ask to pay and reserve a spot for the bag over the phone. The supervisor said that it may end up being cheaper to pay over the phone. Please let me know if you can do anything with the call center.

Once more, if you have any last-minute ski storage problems while traveling before or after the camp, please let me know and I will see if the Sheraton in Malpensa will be able to store your bag. I will need the full name of the bag owner and bag type to give to the hotel.
